Class Descriptions:

Introduction to Theatre:

Students study theatre history, acting, and the technical skills involved in production, and learn to analyze and evaluate live theatre and explore the relationship between theatre and other art forms. Application and two teacher recommendations.

Advanced Theatre 1 (Beginning/Intermediate Acting Technique):

This class is designed to build the acting skill set of the beginning actor. We will focus on scene study, monologue performances and portfolios. This class will produce one

production per school year. Students must be recommended by their middle school drama teacher or by auditioning for the class.

Advanced theatre 2, 3 & 4 (Advanced Production):

This is a performance oriented class. The class will produce two main stage productions during the school year. Students must audition to be in this class. 1 recommendation.

Technical Theatre 1 (Stagecraft)

Stagecraft focuses on the technical aspects of theatre productions. Students will learn painting, set construction, props, costumes, lights and sound. If you like to be behind the scenes and take a hands on class, this is the one for you. Recommendation required.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Middle School Students (Advanced Theatre 1 ONLY) Recommendation by Mrs. Hatcher (Osborne Middle) and/or audition. Non-Osborne students will audition on January 22 at MCHS. Readings will be provided. You do not have to prepare anything for the audition.
2. High School Students
Theatre Arts 1 (Introduction to Theatre) 2 teacher recommendations and application.

Advanced Theatre Arts 2-4:

- A. Complete and turn in this application at the time of your audition.
- B. One recommendation form completed by current or former high school teachers.
DUE Thursday, January 25th
- C. Sign up for an audition time. Auditions are January 29 or 30 during your drama class. You must audition after school if you are not in a theatre class this year.
- D. Prepare 2 contrasting monologues. Each monologue should be 1 minute in length.
