1. Middle School Students (upcoming 9th graders)

Classes available and requirements:

Theatre Arts 1 (Introduction to Theatre) No audition required. Open to any student interested in drama.

Advanced Theatre 1 ONLY

Application and fine arts teacher recommendation-Osborne-Ms. Hatcher.

If you are a Jones student or Osborne student (not enrolled in theatre):

You need to **audition** with a one-minute monologue. You may choose your own or from the selections available on the millcreek theatre website.

Auditions take place January 22nd from 4:15-6 at MCHS. Once you perform your monologue, you are finished with the audition.

2. High School Students (9th-12th grades)

Classes available and requirements:

Theatre Arts 1 (Introduction to Theatre) No audition required. Open to any student interested in drama.

Advanced Theatre Arts 1-4 and Musical Theatre: (10th-12th grades)

1. Complete and turn in this application at the time of your audition.
2. Students enrolled in theatre will audition **January 22** during their drama class.
3. Students not in a theatre class will auditions on **January 22nd** after school. Please sign up for your spot on the drama bulletin board.

Advanced Theatre Arts 1-4:

Prepare 2 contrasting monologues from the selections provided or of your choice.

Musical Theatre 1-4

If auditioning for the musical you must perform a 90 second musical theatre excerpt (you provide accompaniment or a minus track) from a Broadway show and a one minute monologue.

If you would like to be considered for either the musical theatre or advanced theatre arts, you only need to prepare the musical theatre audition. You will be considered for either class.

Class Descriptions:

Theatre Arts Fund 1 (Introduction to Theatre):

Students study theatre history, acting, and the technical skills involved in production, and learn to analyze and evaluate live theatre and explore the relationship between theatre and other art forms. No audition required.

Advanced Theatre 1 (Beginning/Intermediate Acting Technique):

This class is designed to build the acting skill set of the beginning actor. We will focus on scene study, monologue performances and portfolios. This class will produce one production per school year. Audition required.

Advanced theatre 2, 3 & 4 (Advanced Production):

This is a performance oriented class. The class will produce two main stage productions during the school year. Audition required.

Stagecraft 1-2 (Technical Theatre)

Stagecraft focuses on the technical aspects of theatre productions. Students will learn painting, set construction, props, costumes, lights and sound. If you like to be behind the scenes and take a hands on class, this is the one for you. No audition required.

Musical Theatre 1 (Advanced Production)

Musical theatre is a new course that focuses on all aspects of musical theatre-dance, singing, and acting. Students will perform in two main stage productions a year. Audition required
